Night VFR Rating

What is a NVFR?

A Night Visual Flight Rules Rating (NVFR) is a CASA issued rating that entitles the pilot to the freedom of flying at night in Visual Meteorological Conditions. Flying at night is one of the more magical and memorable forms of flying one can do. The NVFR rating is that extra piece of mind knowing that if you don't make it in by last light, you'll still be legal and most importantly, SAFE!

At a Glance:

- Our NVFR rating consists of three main components, Aircraft Handling, Visual Navigation and Radio Navaid/GPS Navigation
- A NVFR Rating allows the holder to act in PIC of an aircraft certified to fly NVFR anywhere in Australia

What is involved?

The MBFS NVFR training syllabus is CASA approved and allows for the maximum level of flexibility and tailoring to the student's individual needs.

The minimum requirements are:

- 10 hours flight time at night including:
 - 5 hours cross country navigation
 - 1 hour solo circuits
- Pass a CASA NVFR Flight Test
- hold a Current PPL, CPL or ATPL

What does it cost?

Flight Component	
Dual Instruction Piper Cherokee PA28 10 hours @ \$410/hr	\$4,100
Aerodrome Lighting Use \$25 x6	\$150
NVFR Flight Test	\$1,400
Approximate Cost	\$5,650
